General requirements for all courses: 5 A*-C grades including English and Mathematics

Subject	Specialist requirements
Art	C Grade in Art GCSE if taken. Entry onto the course for those who have not taken Art at GCSE level will be based on review of a portfolio of your work and an enrolment task.
Applied Science (BTEC level 3)	Merit in Level 2 Science or a B grade in GCSE science (s)
Biology	B grade or above in Biology or AA for Double Science
Applied Business Studies	B grade or above in Maths or English GCSE.
Chemistry	B grade or above in Chemistry or AA for Double Science
Computing	B grade or above Maths
Creative Writing	B grade or above in English Language or Literature
Drama and Theatre studies	B grade or above in Drama or related GCSE
Economics	B grade or above in Maths
English Literature	B grade or above in English language and English Literature at GCSE level
Enterprise and Entrepreneurship (BTEC level 3)	5 A* to C grades or equivalence
French	B grade or above in French at GCSE level
Geography	B grade or above in Geography at GCSE level
Government and Politics	B grade in History or Sociology if studied at GCSE level
Graphics	B grade or above in Graphics at GCSE level
Health & Social Care (BTEC level 3)	Merit or above in Level 2 Health and Social Care if taken.
History	B grade or above in History at GCSE level
ICT (BTEC level 3)	Merit in Level 2 BTEC ICT or C grade or higher in GCSE ICT. B grade in Maths if ICT was not taken at level 2
Mathematics	A or A* in Maths at GCSE level
Media Studies	5 A* to C grades or equivalence including English
Music	B grade or above in Music at GCSE Level
BTEC Sports	C grade or above in PE and Double Science GCSE or competing for a club in any event.
Physics	B grade or above in Physics or AA for Double Science GCSE
Product Design, Resistant materials	Grade C or above in a related GCSE – such as Art, Design Technology or ICT.
Psychology	BCC grades or above in Mathematics, English and Science GCSEs (in any combination)
Religious Studies – Philosophy of Religion	5 A* to C grades or equivalence including English. Available to all beliefs and none.
Sociology	B grade in English or a Humanities subject
Spanish	B grade or above at GCSE in Spanish.
